

**Compassion 06 – Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2021**

**Introduction**

We can see many instances of typology in the Gospels; these tell us more about Jesus and His finished work.

**Main Points of Sermon**

Most of the Gospels is in the Old Covenant; everything written in the Old Covenant can be seen as typology, pointing to the finished work of Jesus Christ.

For example, the following accounts are pieces of beautiful typology –

1. Jesus healing the leper in Matthew 8 is a picture of His finished work, purging, cleaning and saving Mankind.
2. Jesus' crucifixion with His hands reaching out is a picture of His welcome to all of Mankind for whom He died.
3. Jesus' forgiveness of the woman taken in adultery is a picture of His forgiveness of all Mankind, so that in the spirit there is now no condemnation for those in Christ.
4. The leper (one of ten) who returned to Jesus was a picture of Jesus as our High Priest
